WE WILL rescind the fine that we assessed against Randy Boettjer for engaging in activity that was protected by Section 7 of the Act. WE WILL

refund to Randy Boettjer all dues or fees that we received from Southern California Edison for him during the period March 20, 2006, to the present.

Trimburse to Randy Boettjer the legal fees that he expended in

defending a state court lawsuit that we filed against him.
